- 04.31.02 TANITH- I must say, Colonel, I was most intrigued by your means of arrival.
- 04.35.29 O'NEILL- Yeah, it was a sweet ride. A little rusty, but it's still got zip.
- 04.42.15 TANITH- How exactly did a Goa'uld mothership come into your possession?
- 04.47.22 O'NEILL- Well, it was kind of a trade deal.
- 04.52.13 TANITH- How so?
- 04.54.00 O'NEILL- Cronus gave us his ship, and he got what was coming to him.
- 05.01.02 TANITH- Really? Cronus is dead?

- 05.07.24 JACOB/SELMAK- Now that we have access to a mothership, we will be able to move our people and our Stargate as well...
- JACOB/SELMAK (OS CONT)- and thereby establish a completely new and secure base.
- 05.18.11 TANITH- I don't understand. Why have I been excluded from such important information?
- 05.24.15 TANITH- The Tok'ra did not wish Apophis to be informed.
- 05.30.21 JACOB/SELMAK- We've been aware of your duplicity from the beginning. You deceived and then murdered the Jaffa Shan'auc. You took the host Hebron, and you've been acting as a spy amongst us ever since.
- 05.44.28 TEAL'C (OS)- You have been used to channel misinformation...
- TEAL'C (CONT)- to Apophis. He will be most displeased when he learns the truth.
- 05.55.19 TANITH- This is absurd. You will never escape. The System Lords will hunt you down to the ends of the galaxy.
- 06.25.06 O'NEILL- That guy is a living cliché.
- 06.36.25 TEAL'C- I wish to speak to the prisoner.

- 06.49.10 TANITH (OS)- I wasn't...
- TANITH (CONT)- aware I was allowed guests. How kind of you to come and visit me, Teal'c.
- 06.54.02 TEAL'C- My presence here is not motivated by kindness. I am here to deliver your sentence as decreed by the Tok'ra High Council.
- 07.01.22 TANITH- Death, I suppose.
- 07.04.04 TEAL'C- You are to be extracted from the host, Hebron, and left behind here on Vorash. If you are fortunate, you will die before Apophis discovers how you have been used by the Tok'ra.
- 07.14.18 TANITH- I am sure that you would like to kill me with your bare hands, as I did your beloved Shan'auc. You, of all, would appreciate how much more satisfying it is to see the fear and pain in the eyes of your victim as they die.
- 07.33.11 TEAL'C- You took great pleasure in the murder of Shan'auc, but you must understand the price you paid. While Apophis was being diverted by your unwitting deceptions, the Tok'ra were able to move freely through Goa'uld territory untouched, rescuing stranded agents, freeing captured allies. Hundreds of lives were saved by the false information you spread. The Tok'ra owe you a debt of gratitude, Tanith. Were it not for the relative ease with which you allowed yourself to be manipulated, Apophis may have eliminated the Tok'ra.

TANITH (CONT)- She cried out for you like a baby weeps for its mother as I slowly extinguished her life.
- 08.48.19 TEAL'C- You are attempting to goad me into killing you, thereby avoiding the extraction process. I understand it to be excruciatingly painful for the symbiote.
- 09.07.16 TANITH- I am far more valuable to you alive than dead.
- 09.14.01 TEAL'C- The Tok'ra do not believe so. And I am inclined to agree.
- 09.38.14 JACOB/SELMAK- You'll have to take that to the secondary cargo hold. We need to make room for the Stargate.
- 09.43.17 O'NEILL- Hey, don't scuff the walls. I want the ship back the way we found it.
- 09.51.12 JACOB/SELMAK- We know, Jack. I still don't think it's really necessary for you to be here.

- 09.55.14 O'NEILL- Sorry. Not letting her out of my sight.
- 09.57.29 JACOB/SELMAK- My mission is to oversee the relocation of the Tok'ra base. What's yours again?
- 10.02.18 O'NEILL- Protect Earth's big fat asset. We've got about a thousand engineers and scientists just drooling to go through this...
- 10.10.12 JACOB/SELMAK- Do you really think that's wise?
- 10.13.00 O'NEILL- Don't start with me, Jake.
- 10.14.09 JACOB/SELMAK- Do you remember when you tried to retrofit a death glider?
- 10.18.01 O'NEILL- Yes. I have that memory.
- 10.19.18 JACOB/SELMAK- This is a vastly more complicated piece of technology.
- 10.23.21 O'NEILL- Which is exactly why we're loaning it to you in exchange for flying lessons.
- 10.27.29 JACOB/SELMAK- You know what I mean. You should really leave the ship with us.
- 10.30.21 O'NEILL- Not a chance. This is me talking, Jack. Jacob, not Selmak. You have no idea how dangerous this thing is.

- 10.36.29 O'NEILL- Hey! We were smart enough to steal it in the first place, which is more than the Tok'ra have been able to do.
- 10.42.05 JACOB/SELMAN- We don't operate that way.;
- 10.44.04 O'NEILL- Well, maybe it's time you took a more direct approach. The Tok'ra have been around for what? Two thousand years? In all that time, how many System Lords have you taken down?
- 10.53.05 JACOB/SELMAN- Oh, yeah, things have certainly gotten better out here since you started killing Goa'ulds off one by one. Let's examine the results. In each case, more warlike Goa'ulds have stepped in to fill their place. There's more chaos than ever before. - 11.23.23 JACOB/SELMAN- Undermine the Goa'uld's individual power and keep them fighting amongst themselves until we have a way of eliminating them once and for all.

11.34.18 JACOB/SELMAK- We're working on it, Jack.

12.01.06 TANITH- You think you can save my host, Hebron, by separating him from me? I will not allow you to kill me. Hebron's life is in my hands. If I am to die, he will die with me.

12.27.02 FIRST GUARD- The prisoner just collapsed.

12.35.12 TOK'RA # 2- Lower the shield. Lower the shield! We cannot just stand by and allow him to kill the host.

12.57.10 CARTER- We finished loading the supplies onto the ship. It's time to start transporting your people up.

13.02.05 COUNCIL MEMBER (OS)- We'll begin immediately.

13.12.19 JACOB/SELMAK- It's Tanith. He's escaped.

- 14.07.29 O'NEILL- Ah, well, he's boned without water.
- 14.11.06 TEAL'C- His symbiote will sustain him for a considerable time.
- 14.14.01 O'NEILL- Big desert.
- 14.16.08 TEAL'C- I will continue looking.
- 14.19.15 O'NEILL- Keep in touch. So how do you guys know where to stand, anyway?
- 14.49.22 DANIEL- Any sign of him?
- 14.52.10 O'NEILL- Nope. He's still looking.

- 14.54.09 DANIEL- You guys have been out there for hours already.
- 14.57.21 O'NEILL- Yeah, it's a Jaffa revenge thing.
- 15.12.16 JACOB/SELMAK- It seems Tanith's been busy. We've received word from one of our
operatives that Apophis has been given our location.
- 15.19.22 DANIEL- Guess he's trying to make up for the last few months.
- 15.21.29 JACOB/SELMAK- An attack fleet is being assembled.
- 15.23.25 O'NEILL (OS)- How long will it take them to get here?
- 15.25.13 JACOB/SELMAK (OS)- Less than a day.
- 15.27.04 DANIEL- We have to speed up the evacuation.
- 15.29.03 CARTER- We're gonna send them through the gate.
- 15.31.00 O'NEILL- I thought we were gonna take them in the ship.
- 15.33.27 JACOB/SELMAK- Sam and I have come up with a new plan.

15.36.17 CARTER (OS)- If it works...

CARTER (CONT)- we may be able to wipe out a significant part of Apophis' fleet in one shot. This is the sun that Vorash is orbiting. It's a regular, main sequence star with a core temperature of about fifteen million degrees, and enough hydrogen to burn for another five billion years.

15.58.26 O'NEILL- Yeah?

16.00.09 JACOB/SELMAK- We want to blow it up.

16.03.02 O'NEILL- Wow.

16.04.07 DANIEL- That's, uh... ambitious.

16.06.10 O'NEILL (IN UNISON WITH DANIEL)- ambitious.

16.09.13 CARTER- Every star is a delicate balance between the explosive force of the fusion going on in its core, which tends to want to blow it apart, and the gravitational force of its mass, which tends to want to crush it into a little ball. Now, if we can disrupt that balance by suddenly removing some of the star's mass, we could create an artificial supernova.

CARTER (OS CONT)- The blast wave would expand at nearly the speed of light.

CARTER (CONT)- It would destroy everything in this system within a matter of minutes.

16.34.28 DANIEL (OS)- Um...

DANIEL (CONT)- How are we supposed to remove some of the star's mass?

16.39.25 CARTER- Well, ah, this is going to sound a little crazy, but we dial P3W 451. It's the planet where we encountered the black hole.

16.50.03 O'NEILL- Wow. That sounds a little crazy.

16.53.25 CARTER- Yeah.

16.54.24 JACOB/SELMAK (OS)- We take the Stargate...

JACOB/SELMAK (CONT)- in the mother ship and bring it as close to the sun as we can.

JACOB/SELMAK (OS CONT)- Then we dial the black hole...

JACOB/SELMAK (CONT)- enclose the gate in a force field, and jettison it.

17.04.18 CARTER- The sun's gravity will pull it in, the force field will disintegrate, and stellar matter will be sucked through that wormhole like water through a fire hose.

17.13.02 JACOB/SELMAK (OS)- It's likely...

JACOB/SELMAK (CONT)- the gate won't last long, but we figure it will be long enough.

- 17.17.07 DANIEL- Ah, excuse me. Wasn't the gate on P3W 451 sucked in the black hole a long time ago?
- 17.23.29 CARTER- Not necessarily. Now, that planet was probably ripped to pieces, but it could take years for that matter to spiral into the event horizon, especially given the time distortion.
- 17.35.09 JACOB/SELMAK- Either way, we'll know as soon as we try to dial out. If we can't make a connection, we abort the plan and get the hell out of there.
- 17.45.01 O'NEILL- Let me think about this a moment.
- 17.48.24 JACOB/SELMAK (OS)- You're the one who wanted to take more direct...
JACOB/SELMAK (CONT)- measures, Jack. The council's already approved the plan.
But it's your ship, which means it's your call.
- 18.01.17 O'NEILL- Still thinking.
- 18.03.15 CARTER- Sir, the solar system is completely abandoned and barren.
CARTER (OS CONT)- Apophis' fleet is on the way.
CARTER (CONT)- We may never have another opportunity like this again.
- 18.17.06 O'NEILL- Okay.

- 18.32.23 DANIEL- Hey, Teal'c. I've been looking for you. There's been a change of plans.
- 18.39.00 TEAL'C- I have been informed of Major Carter's intentions.
- 18.46.28 DANIEL- So you understand, then, that... that there's nowhere for Tanith to run. This whole planet is going to be incinerated.
- 18.56.10 TEAL'C- If all goes according to plan, yes.
- 19.00.11 DANIEL- What, you don't think we can pull it off?
- 19.03.28 TEAL'C- I have great confidence in both Selmak and Major Carter.
- 19.08.00 DANIEL- But?
- 19.10.05 TEAL'C- Twice I have had the opportunity to avenge the murder of Shau'nac. Twice I have let Tanith slip through my grasp. I have failed Shau'nac.
- 19.22.14 DANIEL- That's...that's not true. You let Tanith live so the Tok'ra could use him, and it worked. And now we're about to take down Apophis and the largest Gou'ald fleet ever assembled.
- 19.37.16 TEAL'C- It will be a great victory.

- 20.46.23 CARTER (OS)- The last of the Tok'ra have been evacuated and the Stargate's been loaded...
CARTER (CONT)- into the cargo bay. We're good to go.
- 20.56.22 O'NEILL- Oh! Shotgun.
- 21.14.10 JACOB/SELMAK- Setting course for the sun. I'm picking up the fleet on long range scanners. At current speed, they'll be here in sixty-eight minutes.
- 21.35.27 CARTER- The timing has to be precise. Once we're close enough to the sun...
CARTER (OS CONT)- we'll slow to five per cent light speed and release the gate.
CARTER (CONT)- That should give us more than enough time to get away.
- 21.44.10 O'NEILL- How much advance warning is Apophis gonna have?

- 21.47.10 JACOB/SELMAK- They won't be able to detect the gate on their screens, and they won't know Vorash is deserted until they're in orbit. By then, it'll be too late.
JACOB/SELMAK (CONT VO FILTERED THRU RADIO)- We're in position. Slowing to five per cent light speed.
- 22.19.28 CARTER (OS)- Cargo base gravity generators engaged.
CARTER (CONT)- Initiating remote dial-out sequence.
- 22.44.02 JACOB/SELMAK- Ready when you are.
- 22.54.20 CARTER- It worked. The gate on P3W 451 is still active. Engaging force...
CARTER (OS CONT)- field.
- 23.07.09 O'NEILL- Something wrong?
- 23.08.21 CARTER- No. I've just never blown up a star before.
- 23.15.29 O'NEILL- Well, they say the first one's always the hardest... I say that.
- 23.26.21 CARTER- Opening cargo bay doors.
CARTER (OS CONT)- Releasing...
CARTER (CONT)- the clamps.
CARTER (OS CONT)- And the gate is away.

24.03.23 JACOB/SELMAK- Gate trajectory on course. Alright. Time to go. Prepare for hyperspeed.

24.22.21 DANIEL- What the hell's that?

24.34.15 O'NEILL- What the hell was that?

24.35.16 JACOB/SELMAK- We're under attack. Teal'c- weapons.

24.47.04 TEAL'C- Shields are inoperative.

24.50.13 JACOB/SELMAK- It can't be Apophis. It's too soon.

24.53.23 TEAL'C- Acquiring target. It is Al-kesh. A Goa'uld mid-range bomber.
